



Laughlin – Resort Overview

Don Laughlin's Riverside Resort Hotel & Casino

Owned by Don Laughlin, the property now known as the Riverside was originally a boarded-up motel purchased by Laughlin in 1966, and became the cornerstone of one of the fastest growing communities and gaming resorts in Nevada. The Riverside has 1,404 rooms in its two towers, five restaurants and a showroom that continually features top-name celebrities. The resort has a state-of-the-art movie theater with six screens; a classic car collection featuring more than 80 rare and historic automobiles; convention facilities; a \$15 million state-of-the-art bowling alley; and supervised children's daycare center. The Riverside operates the U.S.S. Riverside, a luxury tour boat that sails under Laughlin Bridge to Davis Dam and offers daily narrated routes on the Colorado River. A new addition to the complex, Casino West, features a 10,000-square-foot casino with more than 180 slot and video poker machines, a full-service cocktail bar and snack bar. Casino West is located adjacent to the RV park (full hook-up with 740 spaces) and 560-space parking garage. www.riversideresort.com

Golden Nugget Laughlin

Golden Nugget Laughlin is an intimate, 300-room resort located on the banks of the Colorado River. The tropical-themed casino features slot and video poker machines, which includes progressive-play machines; table games, including blackjack, craps, roulette and three-card poker; keno; and a complete race and sports book, which is linked to the Golden Nugget Las Vegas for the most up-to-the-minute betting lines. Unrivaled in Laughlin, the Golden Nugget's race book offers pari-mutual betting, provides access to major sporting events from around the world, and features more tracks than any other race book in Laughlin. The Golden Nugget Laughlin also offers a variety of fine and casual dining at affordable prices, to suit all palates. Restaurants include Joe's Crab Shack, Harlow's, Saltgrass Steak House, The Sports Bar at Tarzan's and The Deli. After dark, Thursday through Saturday, The Sports Bar at Tarzan's transforms into the tropical-inspired Tarzan's Nightclub featuring live DJs and bands. www.goldennugget.com/laughlin

Pioneer Hotel & Gambling Hall

The Pioneer Hotel & Gambling Hall is a unique boutique property, themed as one of the last Old West-style gambling halls and saloons with rich dark woods, ornate wall coverings, sparkling chandeliers and antique one-armed bandits. The Pioneer features more than 400 restful rooms including 80 overlooking the Colorado River, 30 of which are elegant suites – some of the largest in the area. The property prides itself on providing superior customer service, excellent food at modest prices and outstanding gaming choices. The Pioneer offers three main restaurants for its visitors' dining pleasure: Boarding Room; Fast Draw for snacks on-the-go; and the elegant Granny's Gourmet, which has received numerous accolades for its Sunday champagne brunch. www.pioneerlaughlin.com

Edgewater Hotel & Casino

Edgewater features a 50,000-square-foot casino and 1,350 rooms situated on a 16-acre site adjacent to the Colorado Belle with nearly 1,640 feet of frontage on the Colorado River. The casino has more than 1,000 slot machines, 26 blackjack tables, several craps tables and roulette wheels, a poker room, and the largest race and sports book on the river. The Edgewater complex also features the Hickory Pit steakhouse, Garden Room coffee shop and Black Angus Grand Buffet. Additionally, guests have access to the property's wedding chapel, full-service salon and meeting facilities. www.edgewater-casino.com

River Palms Resort & Casino

River Palms features more than 1,000 rooms and 78,000 square feet of hot Vegas-style gaming including 1,200 slot machines on three levels and live table games in the main casino pit along with a poker room and bingo parlor. Guests also have access to seven restaurants including The Lodge for elegant dining, six bars and lounges, an outdoor pool-spa area, and an indoor health-and-fitness club. For meetings and conventions, the River Palms boasts more than 9,000 square feet of convention space and can accommodate groups of any size. www.river-palms.com

Colorado Belle Hotel/Casino & Microbrewery

The Colorado Belle is situated on a 22-acre site on the banks of the Colorado River with nearly 1,080 feet of river frontage. The hotel-casino is shaped like a paddle-wheel vessel and transports guests into the 19th-century world of old New Orleans, Mark Twain and Mississippi gamblers. It features 70,000 square feet of gaming, 1,169 rooms and suites, two heated pools, a spa, food court, four gift shops, a video arcade and live entertainment. It is also home to Laughlin's only microbrewery. www.coloradobelle.com

Tropicana Express Hotel & Casino

Tropicana Express is one of Laughlin's premier destinations for gaming, entertainment and fine dining. The Tropicana features a 24-story luxury high-rise West Tower and a 12-story adults-only luxury East Tower equalling more than 1,500 newly-remodeled guest rooms and suites, many with breathtaking river and/or mountain views. The property boasts 53,000 square feet of gaming excitement with numerous slot machines and table games such as blackjack, roulette and craps as well as a sports book. The Tropicana is home to Laughlin's only working railroad – "Old No. 7." Since its debut in 1988, the train has carried more than 2 million guests around the 27-acre property. The complex also features a unique locomotive-shaped outdoor heated swimming pool and attached spa (the locomotive wheel), with poolside cabanas offering limited food and beverage service. There are five restaurants ranging from casual to fine dining, the Eclipse Bar and the Caboose Lounge offering nightly entertainment and several shopping venues. www.tropicanax.com

Harrah's Laughlin Hotel & Casino

Harrah's Laughlin features more than 1,500 rooms in three towers, five restaurants, four specialty bars, a lounge, two pools, gift shop, boutique, convenience store, arcade, health club and day spa. Sun worshipers flock to the resort's sandy, ocean-style beach fronting the Colorado River. The expansive casino houses more than 1,200 slot machines, 37 table games, a race-and-sports book, keno, poker room and World of Poker gift shop. In addition, the resort offers players high-end slots. The showroom books exciting entertainment year-round, and the 3,000-seat Rio Vista Amphitheater is the spring and fall stage for top-name performers. www.harrahslaughlin.com.

Aquarius Casino/Resort

The Aquarius offers more than 1,900 guest rooms, three restaurants, multiple fast-food options, a sprawling casino with more than 1,500 slot machines, nearly 60 table games, KENO and a race-and-sports book. The 3,000-seat Aquarius Outdoor Amphitheater books spring and fall outdoor concerts to augment year-round entertainment in the Splash Cabaret, an intimate 300-seat showroom. The resort currently has more than 30,000 square feet of meeting space. The largest meetings venue is the ballroom at 19,333 square feet. It accommodates up to 2,100 reception-style and 1,900 theater-style. laughlin.acepllc.com/

Bay Shore Inn

The Bay Shore Inn provides 104 spacious and well-decorated rooms, some with a beautiful bay view. The facility includes a family picnic and barbecue area on the bay, pool and spa, a casual restaurant, lounge featuring video poker and a pool table. For guests' outdoor enjoyment, personal watercraft may be launched from the property.
